#### RESPONSIBILITIES

### **Clinical Assessment + Presentation**

- Provide initial consultations to potential clients to determine therapeutic needs and to assess fit
- Perform accurate initial and ongoing clinical evaluations of client needs by using questionnaires, basic mental health screenings, clinical interviews, etc.
- Develop a customized treatment plan for each client based on data collected
- Monitor client progress and modify treatment plans as necessary. Ensure counseling records are accurately and confidentiality maintained, including the use of files and software databases.
- Practice according to the American Counseling Association's Ethical Standards and applicable laws.
- Provide clients with the necessary resources to reach their mental health goals. For example, homework, interventions, psychoeducation and community resources.
- Partner and coordinate with other private practices, community and medical agencies to help clients sustain progress.
- Prioritize time-sensitive cases and work on cases until completion; reach out to others for assistance, when needed.
- Be prepared to discuss unique and/or complicated cases with the owner of the company for clinical consultation.
- Provide crisis counseling to clients as needed.

### Personal Emotional Regulation

- Incorporate the practice of self regulation and emotional intelligence when working with clients as well as team members.
- Have and enforce clear personal boundaries to maintain optimal mental health.

### Marketing + Administration

- Create and contribute to company marketing campaigns through email blasts, blogs, videos, social media posts, etc.
- Co-lead therapeutic groups and community mental health workshops that provide mental health education and company information.
- Maintain and complete individual Community Connection Plan to improve relationships with key referral sources.
- Promptly attend and participate in all supervision and team meetings bi-weekly.
